

Benevolence Policy

Before any requests for Financial Assistance are considered by the benevolence team, all applicants must complete three steps:

- 1. Complete and submit the Benevolence Application
- 2. Schedule and meet with your Campus Pastor or a Benevolence Team member
- 3. Agree to begin financial counseling within 30 days of receiving any amount of financial assistance

Some notes about the Financial Assistance Process:

Upon completion of the three required steps, the Benevolence Team will meet to review the applicant's request. This process will typically take 7 to 10 business days following the applicant's completion of the three above steps.

Financial assistance is available **up to \$200**. A household may only receive financial assistance **twice in a twelve month period**. Any amount awarded above these limits is solely at the discretion of the Benevolence Team.

Depending upon the request and circumstances, the Benevolence Team may ask for additional documentation not specifically required in the original application.

Any assistance will be paid directly to the creditor or vendor, not to the applicant themselves.

Though you do not need to be a OneLife Church partner to be eligible for Financial Assistance, consideration will be given to those who volunteer and give financially to OneLife Church.
